APPLIES

Agencies or bodies including:

- A Department
- An Administrative Office
- The Victorian Public Service Commissioner (VPSC)
- Special bodies listed in Section 6 of the *Public*Administration Act (2004)
- Victoria Police
- Crime Statistics Agency

Public entities, as defined in section 5 of the *Public Administration Act* (2004) (meaning certain bodies created under an Act, by a Minister or by the Governor in Council that exercise a public function on behalf of the State).

DOES NOT APPLY

Organisations that are excluded by section 84(2) of the *Privacy and Data Protection Act* (2014) inlouding:

- Ambulance Service
- Public Hospital, Public Health Service or Multipurpose Health Service
- Local Councils / Shires
- Universities
- Government bodies or appointed persons from another jurisdiction

Organisations that are listed in the definition of 'exempt body' in section 4 of the *Public Administration Act* (2004) including:

- A committee established under the Parliamentary Committees Act (2003)
- A cour
- Court Services Victori
- The Judicial Commission of Victoria established under the Constitution Act (1975)
- The Office of Public Prosecutions
